AT 0700 MDT TUE AUG 31 2004, THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PUEBLO ISSUED THIS HAZARDOUS WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR SOUTH CENTRAL AND SOUTHEAST COLORADO.

TODAY AND TONIGHT, ISOLATED TO SCATTERED THUNDERSTORMS WILL DEVELOP IN THE EARLY AFTERNOON OVER THE MOUNTAINS, AND SPREAD OVER THE EASTERN PLAINS BY 1500. THE MAIN THREATS FROM THE THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE WIND GUSTS TO 50 MPH, BRIEF HEAVY RAIN AND CLOUD-TO-GROUND LIGHTNING. THE THUNDERSTORMS WILL END DURING THE EVENING IN MOST AREAS, WITH SOME STORMS LINGERING PAST MIDNIGHT ON THE EASTERN PLAINS.
